What:	Travel to Japan with 4-H youth from across the U.S. and live with a Japanese host family during your stay. An adult chaperone will travel with the delegation on all <u>international</u> flights and stay in Japan for the entire exchange period to assist with any delegate concerns/issues. What:	Travel to Japan with 4-H youth from across the U.S. For the first 4 weeks, stay with a host family in the Tokyo area, learn Japanese language in a classroom setting, and explore Japanese culture outside the classroom. After 4 weeks, you will move to a second host family in the Tokyo area or in another area of Japan. Labo and Utrek offer a group camp; No group camp for LEX.
