- 4. Applications must be typed; NO HAND-WRITTEN applications will be accepted.
- 5. Complete application, including at least <u>TWO</u> reference letters completed by a 4-H agent, FFA advisor, and/or an Academic Advisor.
- 6. Read and complete carefully Only completed applications will be considered. A completed application consists of the application, essay, and at least <u>TWO</u> reference letters.

The NMJLF Scholarship Committee judging process: Applications are blindly judged and are based on a point system. It is encouraged that applicants be as explicit and thorough as possible.
