

NM State 4-H Dog School

The New Mexico State 4-H Dog School was designed to help youth and leaders become familiar with the 4-H Dog Project, the different events youth may participate in with their dogs and to promote Responsible Dog Ownership. State 4-H Dog School is two and a half days of workshops and presentations to help develop leadership, self-reliance, sportsmanship, a greater understanding of their dog and citizenship responsibilities by working together to support community dog projects and activities. 4-H members between the ages of 9-18 may attend Dog School, along with leaders, agents and parents. Dogs do not have to be full breeds to participate in 4-H Dog School.

For the safety of the dog and youth:

- Dogs must be six (6) months of age on or before June 1st of the current year. Dogs exhibiting in **agility** must be eighteen (18) months of age on or before June 1st of the current year.
- Dogs must have current Rabies and DA2PPV (5-way) vaccination certificate completed and signed by a licensed, accredited veterinarian.
- **Vaccines must be given to dog on or before May 15, 2017, unless current yearly boosters are not yet due.**
- Dogs must **not** in season (heat).
- Dogs must **not** be aggressive towards people or other dogs.
