Vernon Hall Memorial
4-H Scholarship**



Vernon Hall was a serious student, campus leader, president of the 4-H Alumni organization, athlete, and friend. He headed the 4-H Cooperative House near the New Mexico State college campus and served in the U.S. Army's ROTC. As fighting intensified in Europe, Vernon and other campus cadets were commissioned as Army lieutenants and he soon became part of the Rainbow Division in World War II.

Instead of returning from war to complete his degree, Vernon Hall gave his life in World War II.

This scholarship in Vernon Hall's memory is to continue his tradition of accomplishment, leadership, dedication, and service.

Selection will be based on leadership, service, dedication, and accomplishment.

Award:

This is an endowed scholarship of the New Mexico State University Foundation. Two \$500.00 scholarships awarded annually.

Scholarship Requirements:

- Must be a New Mexico resident and currently enrolled or has been actively enrolled in 4-H
- May be a high school senior (enrolling in NMSU) or any NMSU student – freshman, sophomore, junior, senior, or graduate student

Application deadline:

June 15 of each year (not a postmark date – must **arrive** by this date)

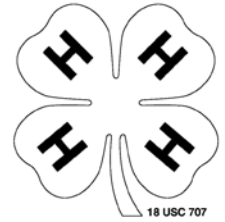
Selection Procedure:
