



REQUIREMENTS FOR A MINOR in AGRICULTURAL BUSINESS MANAGEMENT (ABM)

- AG E 456 - ADVANCED AGRIBUSINESS MANAGEMENT (3 cr)
- AG E 300+ COURSE (3 cr)
- AG E 300+ COURSE (3 cr)
