NM 4-H FCS School of Real Life Skillz will be held March 11-12, 2023, at the Bernalillo County Extension 4-H Center in Albuquerque with participant check -in at 8:30am. The New Mexico 4-H FCS Schools are designed for 4-H members ages 9-12 who are interested in developing skills related to the Family and Consumer Science Projects and learning about project opportunities. 4-H members engage in one track of focus, based on preference and availability. All participants will complete a service-learning project.

This year there are seven tracks offered: Baking, Photography, Sewing, Ceramics, Jewelry Making, STEM and Outdoor Cooking (JUNIORS ONLY).
