

Ribbons through 6th place NO STRESS SHOW → HAVE FUN

This is an All Breed & 4-H training show.

No bling required. Boots; hat, cap or helmet; and long sleeved shirt and pants required. Humane training devices allowed including using two hands with shank bit.

Judge's decisions are final. APHA rules prevail if not addressed in show rules.

Results from this show DO NOT COUNT towards NMPHC year end awards.

Please note that exhibitors must clean up and remove manure & hay before leaving show grounds. Please use dumpster and NOT the recycling bin.

Show office opens at 8 am / Show starts at 9 am (No overnight facilities – Gate opens at 7 am)

Green: First or second year of showing, horse or rider
