

<u>Categories -</u>

- Landscapes Any pictures that have fields, any type of vegetation, flowers, mountains, sunsets, etc.
- Buildings Any picture that have buildings Other -Anything that doesn't fit in a category

- Members May Submit <u>up to a total of THREE entries</u>. Each entry must have the following information with it — Name, Club, County, Name of Photo, Category, Location of the photo and Contact number/email
