Rabbit Information

The Rabbit Hemorrhagic Disease Virus became an epidemic last year.

This virus is highly contagious among the rabbit population and the first sign of infection tends to be the death of the rabbit.

Luckily, there is a vaccine!

In order to have an in-person rabbit show this year ALL participating rabbits MUST be vaccinated and you will need to show proof before your rabbit can enter the fair.

There are two vaccination clinics happening at the end of May, one of the 22nd and one on the 23rd and both require pre-registration.
