



This project is about waterfowl management including types of waterfowl, migration, habitat, and improvement.

#### Exhibit idea for county fair:

Make a poster displaying types of waterfowl that migrate through New Mexico and identify their migration routes on a map.

### Project Highlight: Adventures with Food

The beginning level "Adventures with Food" is a one-time experience for members 9-11 years old and older youth having no experience with cooking.

Exhibit ideas for county fair:

3 cookies using the recipes in the book (oatmeal, peanut butter, or butterscotch fingers)



### Project Highlight: Braiding Self-Determined

In this project, you will expand upon the basic principles of braiding. The self-determined project designation allows you to exhibit your braided item of choice. Make sure to include the Self-Determined form.

Exhibit idea for county fair: 8 plait belt made from nylon cord

#### Contest Highlight: Fashion Revue

Clothing construction projects can be entered in the fashion revue competition at County Contest. There is no fashion revue at county fair. Winners are eligible to move on to the fashion revue at state conference (seniors) or district contest (novices & juniors). Cloverbuds can participate by modeling an outfit made by someone else.
