## Creating a Movie Windows Movie Maker

### Selecting Images

1. **Open** Windows Movie Maker.
2. Select **File>Import into Collection**.
3. **Select** the images you want to import by holding **Control** as you select the images.
4. Click **Import**.
5. To choose images for the movie **select the image**. Then, **Clip>Add to Timeline**.

-or-

**Select the image and drag it** into the timeline viewer.

6. Select **File>Save Project As>OK**. This step only saves the project, it does not create a movie. You can edit the project file by adding audio, transitions, and special effects.

### Creating a Movie

1. With the completed project file **open**, select **File>Save Movie File**.
2. Select **My Computer**.
3. Click **Next**.
4. Enter a movie **name** and select a **place to save** the movie.
5. Click **Next**.
6. Select **Best Quality (Recommended)**.
7. Click **Next**.
8. Click **Finish**.

Making movies is fun and simple with Windows Movie Maker on XP or Vista. Create, edit, and share movies in a few easy steps.
