The council's mission is to assist the College of ACES through recruitment, increasing student internship and employment opportunities, public relations advocacy, and obtaining partnerships that support the College of ACES.

The council is made up of a total of no more than 17 members of the Sam Steel Society and one current ACES student. All former students of the College of ACES who received an associate, bachelor's, master's or doctoral degree shall be regular members of the Sam Steel Society and are eligible to serve on the council. Each member shall serve a two-year term. Nominations for the council are accepted beginning August 1 and due prior to the quarterly meeting of the council held in conjunction with Homecoming each year.
