

4-H Adult Leader Scholarship

Description

In order to promote 4-H club work in New Mexico and to give recognition to volunteer 4-H Adult Leaders, EANM will give \$500, when funds are available, to one 4-H club leader each year to be used toward the expense of attending a Western Regional 4-H Leaders' Forum or any other educational event recommended by the State 4-H office. The purpose shall be support for training to teach 4-H Leaders how to work with 4-H members, strengthen skills as a 4-H leader, deepen their commitment to mentoring youth, and allow them to become better 4-H and community leaders. Applications are available from the EANM State Scholarship Chairman, the State 4-H Office, any Extension Office or from the website: aces.nmsu.edu/ces/eandm.

Eligibility requirements:

1. Any person who has served as a 4-H Adult Leader of a New Mexico 4-H club for at least three years is eligible.
2. No leader shall receive the scholarship more than once.

Instructions to EANM Scholarship Chair and State Treasurer:

The 4-H Volunteer Specialist or 4-H Department Head will select the judging committee, to include one representative from the EANM Scholarship Committee. The State 4-H Volunteer Specialist or 4-H Department Head will be responsible for notifying the President and the State Treasurer of EANM and the recipient of the scholarship. The Treasurer will forward a check in the amount of \$500 to the recipient.
