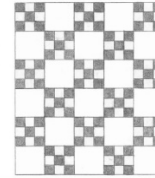
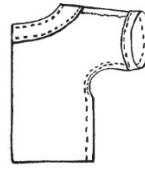




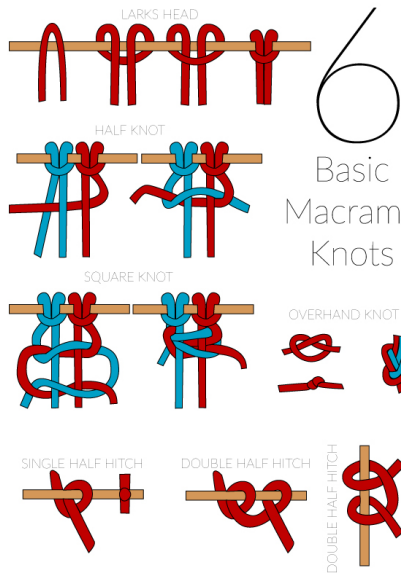

This year you will:

- Review your project book, record sheet and greentop to become familiar with the project before your first project meeting or practice.
- Complete the General Project Guidelines.
- Participate in club, county, district or state contests.
- Participate at county and state fairs.
- For completion of the Macramé Project, complete the record sheet and turn in a county record book to your local Extension Agent.

This project will introduce you to the art of tying knots. The information provided in this project is divided into three levels – Macramé I, Macramé II, and Macramé III. Each level will increase the student skills and accuracy.

In this project, you will learn:

- To tie basic and ornamental macramé knots.
- Macramé terms.
- About macramé supplies.
- To create an original design.

In this project you will:

- Complete a wall hanging (sampler) using at least three of the basic types of knots.
- Complete two simple, small articles using the knots learned while making the sampler.
- Complete two articles illustrating the use of at least six different knots or knot variations.
- Review principles and elements of design and observe macramé articles in local craft shops or bazaars.
- Research the history of macramé in your local museum or library.
- Design and complete your original design.

Citizenship and Leadership Activities:

- Give a talk or demonstration about your macramé project at your club or county contest.
- Assist with fairs or Achievement Day in your county.
- Teach another person one of your skills you've learned.
- Organize a tour of a craft or hobby store for members of your project.
- Donate items created for a 4-H fundraiser.
- Make macramé and donate to nursing home residents or senior centers.
