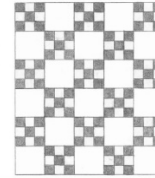
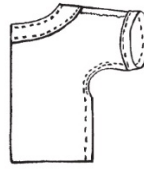

### 4-H "Sew" Much More Fun – Sewing II – Greentop

Welcome to another great year of 4-H sewing! You are ready to have “sew” much more fun as you construct a patchwork pillow, multi-purpose apron, pants, and shirt. You will learn how to use patterns this year as well as ways to organize your closet and look your best.

#### In This Project You Will:

- Learn about fabrics and how to choose them.
- Sew fabric squares into a nine-patch pattern.
- Use patterns to make three clothing items.
- Identify the markings on patterns.
- Choose a pattern size that fits.
- Mark pattern details on a cutout garment.
- Apply facing.
- Sew on a button correctly.
- Hand hem the garments you make.
- Reinforce areas where there is extra stress.
- Evaluate the projects you make.
