AGRO/HORT 462 (Plant Breeding): Principles and practices involved with the genetic improvement of plants.

AGRO/HORT 462 is a 3 credit lecture course that meets twice a week (T/TH 1:30-2:45 PM). The course currently does not have a classroom assigned. I have not taught this course before. The capacity for this course is 20. Currently I have 6 students enrolled in the course.

Since this will be the first time that I will be teaching this course, I will teach the course online. Content delivery and assessment will occur in Canvas. Class discussions will occur during regularly-scheduled class time via Zoom.
