

Getting Your COVID-19 Vaccine

COVID-19 VACCINATION CRITERIA

The following groups are currently eligible for vaccine:



- Hospital personnel
- Residents and staff of long-term care facilities
- Medical first responders
- People working in congregate settings (e.g. correctional facilities, homeless shelters, residential treatment centers, etc.)
- Persons providing direct medical care and other in-person services
- Home-based health care and hospice workers
- People 75+
- People 16+ at risk of COVID complications

NO OTHER GROUPS ARE ELIGIBLE AT THIS TIME

What does it cost to get a COVID-19 vaccine?

- The vaccine is free to all people.
- Per the federal government, providers must administer the vaccine free of charge to any person who wants it, regardless of insurance or immigration status.

When can I get the vaccine?

At this time, vaccine availability is limited. You must register with the New Mexico Department of Health (NMDOH). You will receive a notification to schedule your appointment when the vaccine is available.

How do I register for the vaccine?

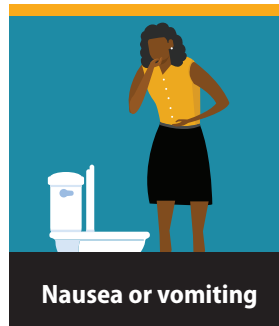
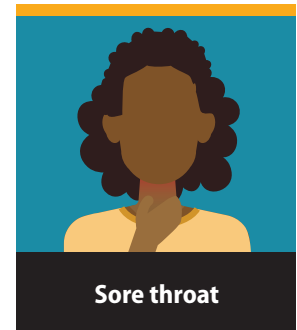
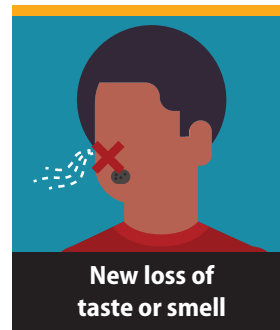
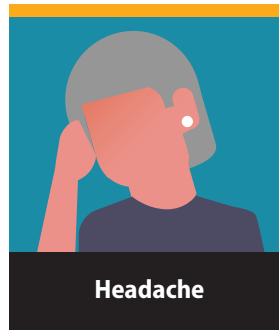
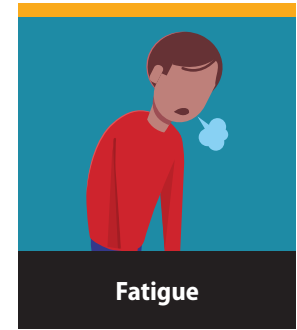
