The Regional Event in Albuquerque will focus on how Occupational Therapists, Physical Therapists, and other rehabilitation professionals can collaborate with AgrAbility, learn about physical rehabilitation issues of farmers and ranchers, effective lighting in agricultural settings, urban and microscale farming, adaptive tools and technology, and worksite assessment. The second day will feature a tour of an urban farm with Agricultura and Mandy's Farm, a project serving people with disabilities in the South Valley. *This event has been approved by the New Mexico licensure boards for PT and OT, and participants can earn up to 13 CEUs at this event.*

AgrAbility is a program sponsored by the US Department of Agriculture that provides assistance to farmers, ranchers and other agricultural workers, and farm family members impacted by disability, illness or chronic conditions. The program is funded through a competitive grant process for one National Project and State/ Regional Projects (currently serving 20 states). Each project involves a collaborative partnership between land grant universities and various non-profit disability services organizations.
