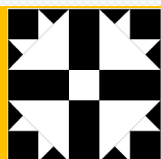
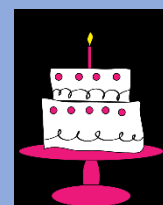

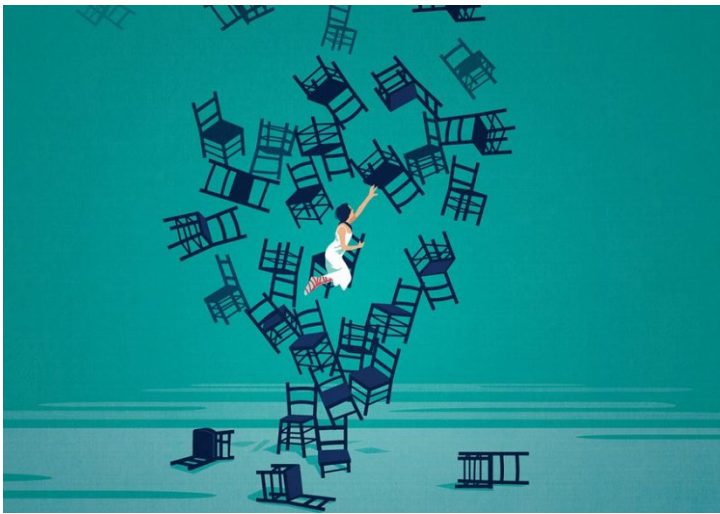

2023 State 4-H Photo Contest Show off your photography skills!

Enter your photos to have a chance of winning the 2023 State 4-H Photo Contest. Photos in either film or digital can be submitted through mail or Facebook by August 1st. (If picture is placed on Facebook, make sure to include the information below with the post). Photos submitted will then be placed on a link and voted on by the public. The information for the voting link will be made available on August 10th. The first, second and third place in each category will receive a rosette. The first place winner in each category will receive a camera case and his/her photo will automatically be entered in the contest for overall winner. The overall winner will be chosen by a set of judges and will be awarded an overall rosette and a cash prize of a \$100.

Categories:

- 4-H – Must have either correct logo or clover
- Animals – Any pictures that have animals
- People – Any pictures that have people
- Landscapes – Any pictures that have fields, any type of vegetation, flowers, mountains, sunsets, etc.
- Buildings – Any picture that have buildings
- Other – Anything that doesn't fit in a category, example - road signs, mailboxes, business signs etc.

Entry rules:

- Members may submit up to a total of three entries. Each entry must have the following information with it—Name, Club, County, Name of Photo, Category, Location of the photo and Contact number/email.
- Entries can be either color or black and white. Please no edited or photo-shopped pictures.
- Please, no matted or framed photos if mailed.
- Photos will not be returned! If you want to keep your photo, please retain a copy.
- Photographs must be the work of the 4-H member taken during the current 4-H program year.
- Entries must in the State 4-H Office or uploaded to Facebook by August 1, 2023. Send to State 4-H Office, MSC 3AE, New Mexico State University, Box 30003, Las Cruces, NM 88003-8003.

RULES:

1. Due to limited space a 6' table is allocated on a first come, first served, basis by registration. Arrangement for space must be made through the County Extension Office. Registration Form may be emailed, mailed or delivered to RA CES.
2. Registration form must be received by July 20th, 2023. Registrations will be confirmed by email.
3. Each 4-H club or FFA chapter may enter only one table.
4. 2023 Spirit Table exhibits should use the theme: "4-H is More . . ." This follows the NMSF theme.
5. Spirit Table exhibits are to be designed and put in place by 4-H/FFA member with little or no assistance from Leaders or parents. Failure to comply will result in disqualification of spirit table.
6. Person(s) responsible for putting in a club Spirit Table will be responsible for keeping the area clean and orderly at all times.
7. Members must provide own supplies.
8. Spirit Table club tent signs will be furnished by the Extension Office.
9. A committee of judges will determine Spirit Table winners. Decision of judges is final.
10. Spirit Tables are to be set up on Monday, July 24th between 1pm and 6pm.
11. Spirit Tables are to be removed on Sunday, July 30th by 12pm.
12. First place 4-H/FFA Spirit Table will advance to represent Rio Arriba County 4-H/FFA at the State Fair.
13. 2023 NMSF booth set-up date to be announced. Booth items must be removed on the announced date by the winning group.

Time to Complete the Annual Working with Minor Training Guidelines for 4-H Volunteers

You may complete the training through the Self-paced model on Zsuites: <https://4h.zsuite.org/>

When you are in your 4H ZSuite account and have selected your profile follow the steps below:

1. Click on Clover Academy on the left menu bar
 2. Launch Clover Academy
 3. Open NM Working with Minors (*even though it says completed*)
 4. Under 'You have earned a certificate' is a button that says *[Reset All Course Progress for New Year (Cannot be undone.)]*
 5. Click on the blue 'Reset All Course Progress for the New Year (Cannot be undone)'
 6. Start Course
 7. Complete the course and a certificate will be available with the completion date. The county 4-H ZSuite administrator should be able to see the volunteer completion on his/her county page.
