It is a requirement to have your project animals tagged and inspected during designated dates in order to exhibit those animals at the Rio Arriba County Fair July 26 - 30, 2023. Exhibitor does not need to be present.

June 24, 9am-12pm **Rabbits & Poultry**


Attend the designated tagging dates to complete a Livestock Nomination Certificate to designate project animals. 4-H Leaders and FFA Advisors sign the completed certificates after tagging to complete the nomination process. Exhibitors will complete an entry form confirming show intentions and indicating the number of livestock pens needed.

Tags cost \$3.50 each (for replacements: 1st time \$3.50; 2nd time \$4.00)



New Mexico 4-H 4-H Communication Team Application-Due June 9 2023 State 4-H Conference

General Information

Six senior 4-H youth will be selected to serve on the 4-H Communications Team (4-H Comm Team) during the 2023 100th State 4-H Conference July 10-14. Youth will document conference and 4-H activities by taking photos and videos, interviewing alumni, 4-Hers and honorees, and preparing media for use by others.

Eligibility

- Youth must be a senior 4-H member that is at least 15 years old to apply. The candidate must be an active 4-H member in good standing with his or her club and council.
- Previous attendance at State 4-H Conference recommended.
- Required orientation meeting on June 15 at 5:00pm via zoom.
- Attend two 2-hour online training sessions prior to conference and at least one-hour online session. Dates will be set at the orientation meeting on June 15 with team members' input.
- Youth selected to serve on the 4-H Comm Team may only participate in one contest at State 4-H Conference as documenting State 4-H Conference will be the priority.

If selected, 4-H Communications Team will pay a \$50 registration fee to cover meals and lodging. This \$50 fee is the total registration cost for State 4-H Conference 4-H Comm Team members (no additional registration fees). The registration process will be completed by the State 4-H Office in coordination with the respective counties. The 4-H Comm Team will be chaperoned by a State 4-H representative rather than their agent.

Interested youth should complete the following application and submit to their county agent who will submit it to cherylb@nmsu.edu no later than June 9. Selected applicants will be notified by June 12th.



<u>Time to Complete the Annual</u> <u>Working with Minor Training</u> <u>Guidelines for 4-H Volunteers</u>

You may complete the training through the Self-paced model on Zsuites: https://4h.zsuite.org/

When you are in your 4H ZSuite account and have selected your profile follow the steps below:

- 1. Click on Clover Academy on the left menu bar
- 2. Launch Clover Academy
- 3. Open NM Working with Minors (even though it says completed)
- 4. Under 'You have earned a certificate' is a button that says [Reset All Course Progress for New Year (Cannot be undone.)]
- 5. Click on the blue 'Reset All Course Progress for the New Year (Cannot be undone)'
- 6. Start Course
- 7. Complete the course and a certificate will be available with the completion date. The county 4-H ZSuite administrator should be able to see the volunteer completion on his/her county page. Just a reminder, all of us that work directly with youth need to take the working with minors training annually.
