Rio Arriba County Tagging Dates

Planning to show your project animal?

It is a requirement to have your project animals tagged and inspected during designated dates in order to exhibit those animals at the **Rio Arriba County Fair, held July 26 – 30, 2023.**

Apr 29, 9am-3pm **Goat, Sheep & Swine**

June 24, 9am-3pm **Rabbits & Poultry**

Exhibitors are required to attend the designated tagging dates and to complete a Livestock Nomination Certificate to designate their project animals. 4-H Leaders and FFA Advisors sign the completed certificates after tagging to complete the nomination process. Exhibitors will complete an entry form confirming show intentions and indicating the number of livestock pens needed.

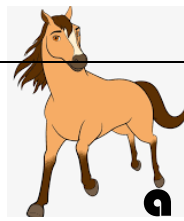
Tags cost \$3.50 each (for replacements: 1st time \$3.50; 2nd time \$4.00)

Enrolled in a Horse Project?

Members looking to participate in 4-H Sanctioned Horse Shows are required to submit a Horse Certificate for the 4-H Project horse. Horse Certificates need to be completed every year. Horse Certificates are due May 1 to the Extension Office.

Enrolled in the 4-H Rodeo Project?

State rodeo rules require all contestants to have personal accident insurance and a signed and completed rodeo waiver in the State 4-H Office 15 days prior to the participant's first rodeo of the current year in order for the member to compete in Sanctioned 4-h rodeos. This includes completing the rodeo safety course.

Apply for Youth Get-Away Counselor or Counselor in Training Today!

Counselor-in-Training (CIT) – any 4-H member who is at least 13 and in the 8th grade or 14 years old may apply. The CIT will work with a counselor in planning activities and leading either a novice or junior age group during the event. *A 13-year-old who is in the 8th grade or a 14-year-old can **only** apply to be a CIT. If an applicant is 15, even if this is their first year applying, they **must** apply to be a counselor.*

Counselor – any senior that is 15 years old may apply. The Counselor will work with a CIT in planning activities and leading either a novice or junior age group during the event.

Counselors and CIT's are chosen through a selection process completed by a panel of judges. Applications require an agent signature.

APPLICATIONS DUE TO RIO ARRIBA COUNTY EXTENSION BY MARCH 13TH

Selected youth will be asked to attend a Zoom session that will be scheduled for the last week of March or first week of April for a counselor/CIT Training.

Counselors/CIT's will need to arrive at Glorieta Adventure Camps on Thursday, April 20, at 5pm to begin the Counselor/CIT training. Dinner will be provided.

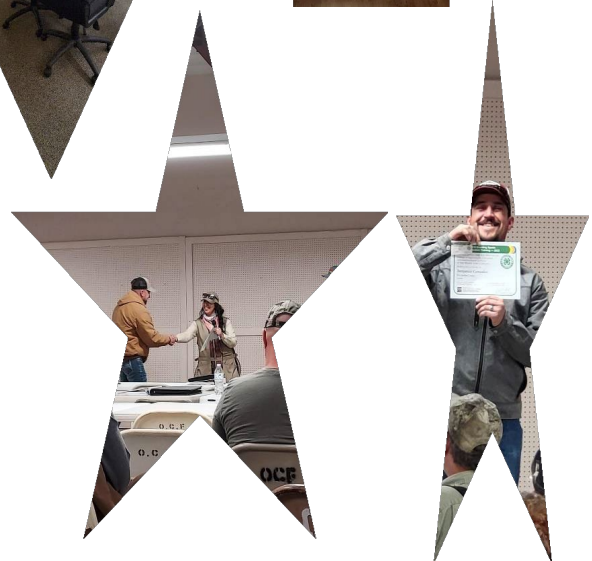
News Alert! Fresh off the Press!!



- **The deadline for 4-H youth and adult chaperones to apply for a scholarship is 11:59 p.m. ET on March 3.** For more information, email Maurice Smith and Christopher Petty at National4-HConference@usda.gov, subject line "National 4-H Conference Scholarship Program."

- **National 4-H Conference Registration is open until 8 p.m. ET on March 8.**

- Registration rates, which include lodging, meals and the welcome packet from April 14 – April 19, are \$810 for youth (double occupancy room) and \$1,300 for adults (single occupancy room). Meals are provided except for dinner on Monday, April 17.

You may complete the training through the Self-paced model on Zsuites: <https://4h.zsuite.org/>

When you are in your 4H ZSuite account and have selected your profile follow the steps below:

1. Click on Clover Academy on the left menu bar
2. Launch Clover Academy
3. Open NM Working with Minors (*even though it says completed*)
4. Under 'You have earned a certificate' is a button that says [*Reset All Course Progress for New Year (Cannot be undone.)*]
5. Click on the blue '*Reset All Course Progress for the New Year (Cannot be undone)*'
6. Start Course
7. Complete the course and a certificate will be available with the completion date. The county 4-H ZSuite administrator should be able to see the volunteer completion on his/her county page. ***Just a reminder, all of us that work directly with youth need to take the working with minors training annually.***
