

Horse Show

The horse show will be on Sunday August 1, 2021.

Show Office will open at 9 am, show will start at time designated by the Superintendent.

The horse show will be held at the Rodeo de Santa Fe arena.

All Livestock in the State of New Mexico fall under the jurisdiction of the New Mexico Livestock Board. Exhibitors must follow all rules established in the 2021 Guide for Livestock Exhibitors. This document is available on the New Mexico Livestock Board website.

In accordance with 77-9-42 NMSA 1978 exhibitors must have horses inspected and have appropriate hauling papers if transporting out of district. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to know if they are transporting out of district to participate in the Santa Fe County Fair Horse show; and to have correct paperwork in hand. Santa Fe County Fair board is not responsible for any fines incurred should exhibitor be cited by NMLB for lack of paperwork.

Santa Fe County Horse Show will follow AQHA rules for classes, requirements and disqualifications. Including disqualification for treatment of horses considered inhumane or cruel.
